Please use the most recent American Psychological Association (APA) style guide format. The current version is APA 5. You can find helpful APA hints at:

If you quote, give the most specific reference possible, that is, a page number for a book, a song title for lyrics.

Please do not use contractions (such as don't)

Reviews will generally be about 500 words.
